SCA to increase pulp price by \$40

SCA will increase the price on bleached softwood kraft pulp (NBSK) in Europe by \$40, from \$820 to \$860. The new price is valid as of February 1, 2020.

“We see the supply of pulp becoming tighter, while the demand for pulp is strengthening”, says Henning Ellström, VP Sales&Marketing Pulp.
