SCA publishes 2022 annual and sustainability report

SCA is publishing its annual and sustainability report for 2022 today. The report sets out how, as Europe's largest private forest owner with the forest as the core of its business, SCA creates stable and profitable value growth over time. The report also covers SCA's high degree of self-sufficiency and investment programme in northern Sweden and the Baltics.

SCA contributes positively to efforts to combat climate change. Through the net uptake of carbon dioxide in its forests, the substitution effect, and low fossil emissions, SCA contributed with a climate benefit of more than 10 million tonnes of carbon dioxide in 2022.
